In June 2018, you will be taking the New York State approved Checkpoint B Examination. This test measures your French proficiency in four areas: Speaking, Listening Comprehension, Reading and Writing. We will be working all next year to improve your skills in these areas. These words, phrases, and grammatical constructions are a collection of vocabulary that you have seen during the past two years. They are also key phrases and words that, if **memorized**, will give you great confidence in your speaking and writing. I have uploaded the set to Quizlet as well. Start your review of this material **EARLY AND DO SOME EACH DAY**. You will be tested in September!

Prepositions of Place

à Paris- to Paris, in Paris de Paris- from Paris
à New York- to New York, in New York de New York- from New York

cities use only à or de. Cities do not have gender.

en France- in France, to France de France- from France
en Italie- in Italy, to Italy d'Italie- from Italy

Countries are either masculine or feminine. Feminine Countries use **en** or **de**.

au Canada - in Canada, to Canada du Canada- from Canada

Masculine countries use **au** and **du**.

aux Etats-Unis- in the United States, to the United States
des Etats-Unis – from the U.S.

Masculine plural countries use **aux** and **des**

Les châteaux – the castles
Le val du Loire- the Loire Valley (where the castles are)
Chenonceau / Blois/ Loches – some castles
Le spectacle son et lumière- Sound and Light Shows (at castles)
